Dear Parent/Carer

Sports Day at TCHA

This year we will be holding our Sports Day on the 3rd and 4th July, the plan for each year group is as follows:

Year 7 will be participating in games based sports on the **morning of Tuesday 3rd July** and should therefore attend school in their PE kit. During the afternoon they will have an additional workshop in school to attend.

Year 8 students will take part in their games based sports on the **afternoon of Tuesday 3rd July** having completed their morning workshop.

Year 9 students will take part in their chosen games based sports on the **morning of Thursday 4th July**, and should attend school in their PE kit. On Tuesday 3rd July year 9 will be taking part in workshops for the whole day and therefore should attend school in normal uniform.

During the afternoon of **Wednesday 4th July all students in Years 7, 8 & 9** will take part in our traditional sports day track events; consisting of 100m, 200m, 400m and 4 x 100m relay. During this time those students not competing will be asked to arrive to school in PE kit and support the students who are competing on behalf of their PL group.

To summarise year 7 & 8 will attend the academy in full PE kit on both Tuesday and Wednesday. Year 9 should attend the academy in PE kit on the Wednesday only.

All of the sporting events that take place on the 3rd and 4th July will happen on the school site and there will be no reason for your son/daughter to be out of school during this time. Year groups that are not taking part in Sports Day will have other activities to take part in during the day such as current affairs and PSHE workshops.

It is imperative that students attend the academy in the correct PE kit; black shorts/trousers, black PE top and black socks. Students must also bring with them appropriate footwear, trainers or boots depending on the activity they have selected, along with a water bottle to remain hydrated throughout the day.

The timings for the school day will run as normal, lunch will be provided as usual during the day and all students will be allowed to leave the academy at 3pm.
